## 2. ECA Dues for 2024 Will Be \$35

As you know, the ECA obtains its funding through voluntary annual dues payments from members. We generally receive support from about 60-65% of the households in the neighborhood. For the last 10 years, dues have remained \$25 per household per year. But, continuing (and more recently accelerated) inflation has gradually eroded our ability to continue the social programs (like the July 4 and Halloween Parades/Parties, Members Socials, New Year Brunch) and other services (like EC-Net, the Neighborhood Directory and neighborhood advocacy) we provide for the community. After debating the topic for the last couple of years, the ECA Board made the difficult decision to raise the dues to \$35 per household per year for 2024. Although dues are voluntary and everyone who lives in this neighborhood is an ECA member, those who also support the ECA financially by paying dues become Voting Members, and can vote in ECA elections. They also receive a printed copy of the ECA's Neighborhood Directory each year, as well as access to the online ECA Directory and phone app.

Thank you for your understanding.
